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KPI's Take Home Message

1. Currently there are no national KPI's for Patient Blood Management (patients undergoing surgical intervention)
2. All national, regional and local audits show inappropriate usage of all blood products
3. Know your trusts strategic plan – build any business cases around the Trusts strategic plan and national guidelines supporting PBM
4. Before agreeing KPI's, audit what you want to change before you implement any change.

Data Collection

1. Agree data you wish to collect – make it appropriate
2. Agree who will own the database and manage it
3. Don't make data collection onerous
4. Know where the data is being pulled/collected from

**Consider using same data set as other
Trusts?**

Agreed KPI's

1. Agreed KPI's - make them realistic, consider both quantitative and qualitative measures!!
2. Agree where the data will be presented, who will present it and how often
3. KPI's may require altering in the future
